All applicants must meet the current eligibility requirements at the time the completed application package is received at the board office. All forms must be legible. Application packages must include all required documentation and fees. Any additional information accompanying the license application must be identified with the applicant's name. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that the Virginia Board receives the completed package.

APPLICANTS APPLYING UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF 18VAC10-20-300.1

Board regulation 18VAC10-20-300.1 states that applicants who are enrolled in a Board-approved surveying or surveying technology curriculum of four or more years and are within 12 months of completing their degree are eligible to take the Fundamentals of Land Surveying Examination. Individuals applying under this provision must submit the following documentation:

- > <u>Surveyor-in-Training Designation Application</u> and fee;
- ► A <u>Certificate of Good Standing</u> from the dean of the school in which the applicant is enrolled. <u>Candidates applying under this</u> provision must submit a completed copy of the Verification of Degree Form within 12 months of receiving their degree.
- > Passing grade on the Fundamentals of Surveying Exam

ALL OTHER APPLICANTS

Individuals <u>not</u> applying under the provisions of 18VAC10-20-300.1 must submit the following documentation. The amount of experience required is based on your level of education (see 18VAC10-20-300 of the *Board for Architects, Professional Engineers, Land Surveyors, Certified Interior Designers and Landscape Architects Regulations).*

- > <u>Surveyor-in-Training Designation Application</u> and fee;
- > Official school transcripts (if applicable);
- Documentation of completion of the Apprenticeship Program by submission of the <u>Apprenticeship Action Form</u> issued by the Department of Labor and Industry;
- Experience Verification Form(s) on the Surveyor-in-Training Designation Application.
- > Passing grade on the Fundamentals of Surveying Exam

EXPERIENCE and EDUCATION

- Applicants must submit official transcripts for all education for which credit is sought.
- Applicants who have earned a degree from an institution outside the United States must have their degree authenticated and evaluated by an education evaluation service if credit is sought for the education. The Board reserves the right to reject an evaluation submitted by an applicant.
- All experience must be verified by and earned under the supervision of a licensed land surveyor and/or a licensed Surveyor Photogrammetrist.
- Please reference the chart below to determine the amount of experience needed to qualify based on your education:

Board-approved survey curriculum of 4 years or more	None
Survey related curriculum of 4 years or more	1 Year
4-year bachelor's degree in a field unrelated to surveying	2 Years

High school with successful completion of courses in algebra, geometry, and trigonometry	8 Years

TOEFL iBT

Applicants for licensure must be able to speak and write English to the satisfaction of the Board. Applicants from a non-English speaking country or a country where the primary language is not English, who have not graduated from a college or university in which English is the language of instruction, shall submit to the Board a TOEFL iBT (Test of English as a Foreign Language) score report that reflects a score acceptable to the Board. A score of 20 or better is required in each exam category. Score reports shall not be more than two years old at the time of application.
